

Meeting of April 2, 2008

- Five Board members were present; Chad Hood and Paul Fields were absent.
- Approved March minutes with change. (Unanimous.)
- Approved an “Intent to Fund” the FY 2008-09 budget request from Scott County School System. (Unanimous)
- Nominated Revolver Drive and Prowler’s Drive for receipt of Rural Addition Road funds. Revolver Drive was selected. (Vote [respectively] – 5-2)
- Authorized County Administrator to proceed with the Rural Addition procedure using available funds to complete Revolver Drive in District 2. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized County Administrator Hood to issue a letter to Senator William Wampler and Delegate Terry Kilgore outlining the danger created to citizens due to lack of a guardrail on Cliff Mountain Road, Gardner’s Chapel Road and Stanley Valley Road. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized the Planning Commission to proceed with the zoning notification process and to contact the Board if additional funding is needed. (Unanimous.)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-18 – “Resolution Declaring that a Local Emergency no Longer Exists in the Lines in the Town of Dungannon in Scott County, Virginia” (Unanimous.)
- Approved donating \$15,000 to the High Knob Enhancement Corporation for assistance in the project to rebuild the tower with one-half of the amount paid immediately from Board Contingency and the other one-half included in FY 2008-09 budget. (Voting Aye – 5; Fields voted Nay; Parks Abstained)
- Appropriated the following: \$15,146.28 to Sheriff’s Department; \$219 to County Attorney; \$5,000 to Recreation. (Unanimous.)
- Directed Treasurer to issue checks for the following: \$167.22 to Tom H. Addington for erroneously paid personal property taxes and \$504.33 to GMAC for erroneously paid personal property taxes. (Unanimous.)
- Approved the claims. (Unanimous)
- Approved Tourism Director Job Description. (Unanimous.)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-12, “Association of Tennessee Valley Governments Resolution.” (Unanimous.)
- Authorized County Administrator Hood to draft a letter of support of the Coalfield Coalition’s grant request to the Virginia Tobacco Commission for a proposed Southwestern Virginia regional multi-use trail system feasibility study. (Unanimous.)
- Approved establishing a rabies clinic in Scott County. (Voting Aye – 6; Redwine abstained.)
- Authorized advertising for a vacancy on the Planning Commission. (Unanimous)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-10, “National Public Safety Telecommunicator’s Week.” (Unanimous)
- Entered Closed Session to discuss A.3 Real Estate being property in Gate City. (Unanimous)

- Directed County Administrator Hood to contact Sheriff Puckett concerning Scott County Deputies being employed at Colonial Downs as part-time security guards. (Consensus.)
