

Meeting of June 4, 2008

- All seven members were present.
- Approved all May minutes. (Unanimous.)
- Tabled action for 30 days on proposed “Ordinance to Provide for the Regulation of Commercial Dog Breeding Operations in Conjunction with Article 2.1 of Chapter 27.4 of Title 3.1 of the Code of Virginia.” (Voting Aye – 5; Abstained – Redwine and Fields.)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-17, “Secondary Six-Year Road Plan.” (Unanimous)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-18, “Resolution Implementing Changes to Personal Property Tax Relief Act in Scott County.” (Unanimous.)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-19 setting the tax levy at \$0.69 for Real Estate and Manufactured Homes; \$0.69 for Public Service Corporations; \$1.40 for Personal Property; and \$0.72 for Merchants Capital and Machinery & Tools. (Unanimous.)
- Adopted FY 2008-09 Budget. (Unanimous)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-21, appropriating funds to the budget line items. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized County Attorney Sally Little to advertise for public hearing on an ordinance to collect the County’s portion of admissions tax that is collected by Colonial Downs off-track betting facility. (Unanimous)
- Appropriated \$13,608.40 to Rescue Services for Four for Life funds. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized Treasurer Kevin Helms to issue a check to Mr. Otis Dockery for \$39.56 for an overpayment of building permit. (Unanimous.)
- Appointed Donna Meade to serve a four-year term on the Regional Library Board. (Unanimous.)
- Nominated Patricia McMurray and Rex McCarty to serve on the Mountain Empire College Advisory Board. Rex McCarty was appointed. (Vote [respectively] 2-5).
- Appointed Patricia McMurray to serve an additional term on the Mountain Empire Community College Advisory Board. (Unanimous)
- Appointed Don Stokes to represent District 1 on the Recreation Advisory Board. (Unanimous)
- Appointed Jeffrey Peters to represent District 3 on the Recreation Advisory Board. (Unanimous.)
- Appointed Johnny Trent to represent District 5 on the Recreation Advisory Board. (Unanimous)
- Appointed Harold Snodgrass to a four-year term on the Planning Commission. (Unanimous.)
- Approved claims. (Unanimous)
- Approved year-end claims. (Unanimous)
- Approved year-end bookkeeping. (Unanimous)

- Approved RADA as the administrator of Indoor Plumbing Rehabilitation Funds for Scott County. (Unanimous)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-20 “Resolution in Support of Multi-Use Trail System in Southwest Virginia.” (Unanimous)
- Did not approve a request from Wise County to pay \$18,501 as a portion of the debt owed by Heart of Appalachia. (Unanimous)
- Adopted Resolution 2008-16 “Tribute to Ronald C. Flanary.” (Unanimous)
- Approved paying for necessary inoculations for a volunteer from the Humane Society so the volunteer can work at the Animal Shelter. (Unanimous)
- Paul Fields was excused from the meeting.
- Entered Closed Session to discuss A.3 Real Estate being solid waste center and prospective industry. (Unanimous)
