

Board Meeting October 1, 2008

- Six Board members were present; Mr. Fields was absent.
- Minutes from September meeting were approved. (Unanimous)
- Authorized Sheriff Puckett to access 100% of all traffic violation fines that are collected, with the Sheriff's assurance that half will be used for unbudgeted items and half will be used for normal budget items. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized establishment of a special fund for the traffic violation fines. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized advertisement for a public hearing on November 5 on a proposed ordinance for business, professional and occupational license fee in Scott County and established the proposed fee at \$20. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized Treasurer Kevin Helms to issue a check for erroneously paid personal property taxes (\$72.32). (Unanimous)
- Adopted a resolution proclaiming October 5-11, 2008 as Fire Prevention Week in Scott County. (Unanimous.)
- Appropriated to the following budgets:
 - Sheriff's Office – Maintenance and Repair of Vehicles
 - E911 – Wireless Grant – accept and appropriate
 - County Administrator - fuel reimbursements
 - Courthouse Security Fund – transfer between line items
- Approved Bailey & Associates for conducting the 2009 reappraisals in Scott County. (Parks voted Nay.)
- Appointed Joe Horton to vote for Scott County at the annual conference for the Virginia Association of Counties. (Unanimous.)
- Recommended Freddie Dockery for mowing Economic Development Authority portion of hay in the Dungannon Industrial Park. (Unanimous.)
- Set October 30, 2008, 6:00 p.m., Scott County Career and Technical Center as the date, time and place to hold the public hearing on the proposed zoning ordinance. (Unanimous.)
- Authorized advertisement for an opening on the Duffield Development Authority for an unexpired term. (Unanimous.)
