

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ADJOURNED MEETING SUMMARY
May 22, 2012

All Member were present

Approved funding Hope House \$3,500 – 6 ayes and 1 nay

Approved funding Junction Center for Independent Living \$5,500 – 6 ayes and one abstention

Approved funding Brain Injury Association \$550 – unanimous

Denied funding Economic Bridge – unanimous

Approved funding Humane Society \$2,500 – unanimous

Approved funding County Administrator Contingency \$5,000 and removed contingency from all other departments – unanimous

Approved funding Commissioner of the Revenue \$5,802 to keep two employee's salaries at their current amount – four ayes and three nays

Approved funding Information Systems Manager \$5,000 to purchase equipment as needed – six ayes and one nay

Approved level funding in the amount of \$55,000 to pay election staff – unanimous

Approved a pay increase for election staff from \$125/day to \$150/day – unanimous

Approved funding General District Court \$920 for Video Conferencing Equipment – unanimous

Approved moving the VA Wireless Grant to a special fund – unanimous

Approved funding the Sheriff's Office \$17,000 to pay overtime for investigators – three ayes and four nays

Approved funding Sheriff's office \$12,000 to pay overtime for investigators – unanimous

Approved funding Sheriff's office \$95,000 to purchase three vehicles and equipment for those vehicles – unanimous

Approved funding Victim Witness \$1,881 to keep current salary – three ayes and four nays

Approved funding an additional \$5,000 annual contribution to Fire Departments – six ayes and one abstention

Approved funding an additional \$5,000 for Fire Departments to purchase fire trucks – six ayes and one abstention

Approved level funding in the amount of \$211,444 for the Regional Library Board – unanimous

Approved an additional \$1,960 for Soil & Water Conservation – five ayes and two nays

Approved contracting to rent the Scott County Park and Golf Course Fairway mower for one year as long as it does not increase in price - five ayes and two nays

Approved a 6.25 percent pay increase for county employees to help offset the VRS increase and thus eliminate a reduction in net pay for employees - two ayes and five nays

Approved a 5 percent pay increase for county employees – five ayes and two nays

Funded an additional \$1,576,604 above the State requirement for the School system for a total allotment of \$6,393,908 for the FY 13 school year - six ayes and one nay
