

PARK MAINTENANCE WORKER/CLUBHOUSE ATTENDANT

GENERAL DEFINITION OF WORK: Duties consist of indoor and outdoor work involving maintenance and care of the Scott County Park & Golf Course, related custodial work, cashier, pro-shop attendant and assisting with other projects as assigned by the Director or Assistant Director of Parks and Recreation, which may include work at other County-owned parks and recreation areas. Note, the Park Maintenance Worker/Clubhouse Attendant will work under the general supervision of the Assistant Director of the Park.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS/TYPICAL TASKS:

(These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

- Assists in mowing and trimming at the Scott County Park & Golf Course.
- Mows and trims greens, tees, fairways and rough with many types of equipment.
- Cuts, prunes and trims trees, shrubs and hedges; mows grass; rakes leaves; removes fallen limbs; performs related custodial tasks.
- Waters, seeds, and sods turf areas; fertilizes, aerates, and applies chemical treatments for turf areas.
- Performs rough carpentry, plumbing, and painting in the repair, maintenance and construction of park and ground structures and equipment.
- Maintains and repairs irrigation system.
- Operates light automotive or power equipment in connection with above tasks.
- Checks in golfers, handles golf transactions, and maintains golf pro shop area.
- Assists in maintenance of all equipment and related projects.
- Performs other duties as required or assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES: General knowledge of lawn care to include maintenance of greens, tees and fairways; ability to operate several types of equipment to include mowers, front end loaders, back hoes, trenches, box graders, etc. in a safe manner; mechanical ability to assist with the upkeep of the golf course equipment; general carpentry skills required during construction/maintenance projects; ability to work in various weather conditions; ability to understand and carry out instructions; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates and the general public.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school and some experience in the performance of grounds maintenance, horticulture and repair work.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: This is medium work requiring the exertion of 50 pounds of force occasionally, up to 20 pounds of force frequently, and up to 10 pounds of force constantly to move objects and some heavy work requiring the exertion of 100 pounds of force occasionally. Work requires stooping, kneeling, crouching, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, fingering, grasping, and repetitive motions. Vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word, hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels. Visual acuity is required to depth perception, color perception and visual inspections, operation of machines, motor vehicles or equipment, determining the accuracy and thoroughness of work, observing general surroundings and activities. The worker is subject to inside and outside environmental conditions, extreme cold, extreme heat.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possession of appropriate driver's license valid within the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential tasks.
