Scott County Public School Head Start is seeking bids for total construction and assembly of an age-appropriate playground serving children six weeks to three years of age located at 303 Legion St. Weber City, VA 24290. The bid must include poured-in-place rubber surfacing, two shade structures, one adult-sized bench, free standing musical equipment, free standing age-appropriate equipment, and two age-appropriate playground structures with slides. The space measures approximately 1,459 sq. feet. Bid must include the removal of existing concrete walkway, preparation of existing area to include drainage, grading and any additional construction necessary, installation of surfacing, certified installation of all equipment, and playground edging. A pre-bid date of August 9, 2018 will be available for potential vendors to discuss the construction and assembly with personnel at 9:00 a.m. at the above address. All bids are required to be sealed and delivered by mail or in person on or before August 16, 2018 to Scott County Public School Board Office 340 E. Jackson St. Gate City, VA 24251. Please mark all sealed bids: **Weber City Early Head Start Playground Bid-Attn: John Ferguson. Bids will be opened on August 17, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. prevailing time.**

Work performed must meet ASTM safety standards, CPSC guidelines, and State of Virginia licensing requirements.

All potential bidders must be a licensed general contractor and provide a copy of license when the bid is awarded.
