We would like a bid for each school as listed below, and one bid as a total project for all installations. Please add a 20% contingency allowance on all bids.

Gate City High – 178 Harry Fry Drive, VA 24251

- 2" Capped area= Approximately 14,584sf

Weber City Elementary – 322 Jennings Street, Weber City, VA 24290

- 3" Binder & 2" finish coat in New areas= Approximately 6,475sf

The purpose of the pre-bid conference is to allow potential bidders an opportunity to present questions and obtain clarification relative to this solicitation and visit the project site.
