Scott County Schools Maintenance Department will install the electrical circuits needed to provide the power for the mitigation equipment. We have identified 34 classrooms that will need the equipment installed between the three schools listed above. Contractors will be required to work with the local builder inspector for the mechanical part of the installation if needed and as required. Scott County Schools will get the required permits for the electrical installation.
