Scott County Virginia Schools is seeking a bid price for major tree trimming and whole tree removal including all wood and brush. For the schools with a complete tree removal, we request for the stump to be ground to at least 10-12" below grade and remove the chips from the grinding. Work requested will be at the following schools:

1. **Dungannon Intermediate**, 113 Fifth Ave., Dungannon, VA 24245 – Four trees to remove.
2. **Rye Cove High School**, 164 Eagle's Nest Lane, Duffield, VA 24244 – Two trees to trim and three trees to remove.
3. **Rye Cove Intermediate**, 158 Memorial School Lane, Duffield, VA 24244 – One tree to remove.
4. **Weber City Elementary School**, 322 Jennings Street, Weber City, VA 24290 – One tree to trim and one tree to remove.

Companies are required to provide an insurance certificate of coverage with a \$1 million minimum to be submitted at time of bid.

Sealed bids will be received at the Scott County School Board Office, 340 East Jackson Street, Gate City, Virginia 24251 until 1:00 p.m. local prevailing time on Tuesday, April 16, 2019 at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Bids should be sealed in an envelope marked "Tree Trimming" and marked attention John Ferguson, Superintendent.

An optional pre-bid conference will be held Thursday, April 4, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the Scott County School Maintenance Office, 298 Jennings Street, Weber City, VA 24290. The purpose of the conference is to allow potential bidders an opportunity to present questions and obtain clarification relative to this solicitation. After pre-bid conference, job site visits will be permitted.
