**WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION**

COMES NOW PETITIONER, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NICKELSVILLE, VIRGINIA, by counsel and pursuant to Code of Virginia § 24.2-226 and requests that this Court issue a Writ of Special Election for Tuesday, November 5, 2019, to fill the office of Mayor. Good cause having been shown, it is SO ORDERED:

Pursuant to Code of Virginia § 24.2-683, this Court does hereby issue this Writ of Special Election, and directs the Electoral Board of the County of Scott, Virginia, to conduct a special election to fill the office of Mayor for the Town of Nickelsville, Virginia, on **Tuesday, November 5, 2019**, in the manner and at the places as would be executed for a general election. This Court further ORDERS the Electoral Board and Registrar to observe the directives set forth in § 24.2-681 *et seq.* of the Code of Virginia when conducting this special election. This Court further ORDERS that the Secretary of the Electoral Board shall post a copy of this Writ on the official website for the County and have notice of the election published once in a newspaper of general circulation in this jurisdiction at least 10 days before the special election.

The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Writ to the Secretary of the Electoral Board and to Counsel for Petitioner, and to strike this matter from the docket.
