**Early Voting in Virginia**

Scott County voters will have new options for voting ahead of the November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 Presidential Election. Virginia will now be offering three distinct ways in which all eligible voters can choose to vote.

**Early Voting in Person**

Any qualified registered Scott County voter can now vote early in the General Registrar's Office. Early Voting begins on Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>, and will end on Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>. The Scott County General Registrar's Office will be open Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to accommodate any voters who wish to vote early. Additionally, the General Registrar's office will be open on Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, and Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. for Early Voting.

Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup> is the last day to vote early.

**Absentee Voting by Mail**

Beginning on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 any registered voter may submit an application to receive an absentee ballot through the mail. We will begin mailing ballots September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020. To request an Absentee Ballot by Mail apply online at <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov> you may also contact the General Registrar's Office to request an application.

October 23<sup>rd</sup> is the last day to request an Absentee Ballot by mail.

**Election Day Voting**

In-Person voting will continue to be available at all regular polling locations in Scott County on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020. Precincts will open at 6:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. If you are in line at 7:00 p.m., you will be able to vote. Do not get out of line if you are in line to vote at 7:00 p.m.
