Separate sealed Bids for the Reroof of Weber City Elementary School for the Scott County Public Schools, will be received by Robert Sallee, Maintenance Supervisor, at the office of the Scott County School Board 340 East Jackson St. Gate City, VA, until **3:00 P.M.**, local prevailing time, on **January 12, 2023**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. The project consists of the removal of the existing roofing material and insulation down to the deck and installation of new fully adhered single-ply EPDM roof membrane on new insulation board on the existing roof deck, per the drawings and specs.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **January 4, 2023** at **3:00 P.M.** All interested parties are requested to meet the Architect at Weber City Elementary School, 322 Jennings St, Weber City, VA at that time.

Withdrawal of bids shall be according to procedure (i) of the Virginia Public Procurement Act and to the Code of Virginia (§ 2.2-4330). Any Bidder must give notice in writing of its claim of right to withdraw its Bid within two business days after the conclusion of the Bid Opening Procedure. If a Bid is withdrawn, the next higher Bidder shall be deemed to be the Low Bidder. No Bid may be withdrawn unless said withdrawal is permitted by law.

Bids must be accompanied by Bid security as specified in the Instructions to Bidders.

Each Bidder must be licensed as a Class A contractor in the State of Virginia; Bidders are instructed to review the *Code of Virginia*, Title 54.1, Chapter 11, prior to bidding.

The Owner does not discriminate against faith-based organizations in accordance with the *Code of Virginia*, § 2.2-4343.1.

The Contract(s) shall be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder(s).

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids if it appears in its best interest to do so.

The project is subject to Davis-Bacon act. Refer to specifications for current wage determination requirements.
