Separate sealed Bids for the Installation of Netting at Softball Field Scott County Sports Complex for the Scott County Public Schools, will be received by Robert Sallee, Maintenance Supervisor, at the office of the Scott County School Board 340 East Jackson St. Gate City, VA, until **2:00 P.M.**, local prevailing time, on **January 24, 2023**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. The project consists of the removal of the existing netting and poles at Gate City High School Softball fields and installed at the Scott County Sport Complex with new foundations and guy wires, per the drawings and specs.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **January 18, 2023** at **2:00 P.M.** All interested parties are requested to meet the Architect at Scott County Sports Complex 782 Filter Plant Ford, Gate City, VA 24251 at that time.

Withdrawal of bids shall be according to procedure (i) of the Virginia Public Procurement Act and to the Code of Virginia (§ 2.2-4330). Any Bidder must give notice in writing of its claim of right to withdraw its Bid within two business days after the conclusion of the Bid Opening Procedure. If a Bid is withdrawn, the next higher Bidder shall be deemed to be the Low Bidder. No Bid may be withdrawn unless said withdrawal is permitted by law.

Bids must be accompanied by Bid security as specified in the Instructions to Bidders.

Each Bidder must be licensed as a Class A contractor in the State of Virginia; Bidders are instructed to review the *Code of Virginia*, Title 54.1, Chapter 11, prior to bidding.

The Owner does not discriminate against faith-based organizations in accordance with the *Code of Virginia*, § 2.2-4343.1.

The Contract(s) shall be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder(s).

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids if it appears in its best interest to do so.

The project is subject to Davis-Bacon act. Refer to specifications for current wage determination requirements.
