



May 28, 2019

The Scott County Electoral Board met at 9:00 a.m. at the Community Service Building, 190 Beech Street, suite 204, in the Electoral Board Conference Room. Present were Chairman Walter Rose, Vice-Chairman Dennis Culbertson, Registrar Mike Edwards and Assistant Registrar Tammy Presley. Absent was Secretary Joe Quillen.

Chairman Walter Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Edwards explained that Secretary Quillen had called earlier this morning to say that he would be unable to attend today's meeting. Due to his absence, the Board decided to wait until the next meeting to read and approve the minutes.

In old business, the Board continued to discuss Election Officials for the November 5, 2019 County Election. Mrs. Presley updated the Board of the Election Officials that have contacted the Registrar's office with either a "yes" or "no" on their availability for the election.

Upon a motion by Dennis Culbertson, duly seconded by Walter Rose, the Board approved the Equipment Loan Agree that was drafted by Scott County Attorney Sally Kegley. This agreement was for the Scott County Republican Party to use the DRE voting equipment that is no longer used by the Electoral Board. All members present voted in favor of the motion.

A discussion was held regarding two (2) special elections that will be held in conjunction with the November 5, 2019 General Election. The Scott County Circuit Court has issued a Writ of Election for the Town of Nickelsville. A vacancy has occurred in the Mayor's position. The deadline to file to be a candidate for this vacancy is June 11, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

The Scott County Circuit Court has also issued a Writ of Election for the Town of Weber City's vacancy in the Mayor's position as well. The deadline to file to be a candidate for that position is August 16, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. The Registrar explained that the reason for the two deadlines is based upon when the vacancies occurred.

Upon a motion by Dennis Culbertson, duly seconded by Walter Rose, the Board approved the Annual Election Service Agreement with Atlantic Election Services. All members present voted in favor.



In other business, the Registrar reminded members that the Annual Training in Richmond will be Monday, June 24th for the Registrar and Tuesday, June 25th for the Electoral Board.

The Board set the next meeting for June 14, 2019 at 2 p.m.

Upon a motion by Dennis Culbertson, duly seconded by Walter Rose, and having no other business presented to the Board, the meeting adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
