The Board met to discuss with Mrs. Starnes about the possibility of County employees taking over delivery and pick up of the Voting Machines. In the past few years, the Electoral Board has been providing this delivery service. However, it has come to the point that the Electoral Board can no longer efficiently continue to deliver the Voting Machines. A discussion was held about the County delivering the machines and equipment. It was decided that this is not something they would prefer to do at this time. The other option is to contact Atlantic Election Service to get a quote for their delivery service as they provide this to other localities. Mike will get a quote and report back to the Board Aug. 19 at 2:00 P.M.

The Board also discussed Ballot styles for the upcoming Nov. election and the number of ballots needed. Joe made a motion to purchase 15000 County Wide Ballots, 400 ballots for Nickelsville town residents and 1000 Ballots for Weber City town residents. Motion was seconded by Pat, all in favor voted yes.

At 3:20 the meeting was adjourned and next meeting was set for August 19,2021 at 2:00 P.M.
